 - iii. Mentors meet on Thursdays only take about 20 students. This is a partnership with one of the local fraternities
 - iv. Use other locations weekends and work with parents for schedules
 - h. Student Voices Committee

- i. Started at the high school level last year and now the county wants middle schools to have it
- ii. 19 students applied and all got in this is for all grade levels
- iii. Have not met yet will meet after school next week
- iv. This is similar to SCA
- v. Isolate areas of growth; look at results from survey last year
